Frequently Asked Questions:

How will I find my first block class?

On Tuesday at 10:30am, students will meet their Block B teacher outside the school.

Grade 7 students organize in the tennis courts – located near the entrance of the school.

Grade 8 and 9 students organize on the south school field.

All students and parents will receive an email to inform them who their block B teacher is on Friday, September 3rd. Student lists will also be posted upon arrival.

More detailed information will be emailed to you this Friday.

What will be the block rotation on the first day of classes?

*For the first day, blocks will be **B A D C***

What time do classes start on Tuesday, September 7th?

*Classes start at **10:30am**. Classes will be organized on the school field starting at 10:30am.*

Families will receive additional information via email on Friday.

Who attends on September 7th?

ALL students – grade 7, 8 and 9 – attend classes starting on September 7th.

What school supplies should I bring?

Students should arrive with:

- *a binder*
- *paper*
- *pen/pencil*
- ***a mask***
